

Y Care's Sponsored Walks 2012

Walk: Pans Midnight Walk

Date: Friday 31 August - Monday 3 September 2012

Introduction:

Experience the Pans in the night under the full moon AND during the day! Start and finish at Mosu village, at the south end edge of the Makgadikgadi Pans. Walking to/and camp at Kubu Island, famous for its beauty, history and many baobab trees. Walking approx. 45km/day (for the walk Mosu-Kubu and Kubu-Mosu).

Program:

Friday: Arrival to Mosu village. Enjoying supper and the sunset over the Pans. After supper, the full moon will light up our path on the Pans for our walk to Kubu Island.

Saturday: In the morning, we reach Kubu Island where the camp has been set up and breakfast is served. Saturday is a relaxing day with various options to choose between: guided tour around the historical island, a walk to a unique flaming nesting site or a walk to Little Kubu. Lunch as lunch package. Evening spent at the camp fire.

Sunday: Breakfast and heading off for Mosu village. Dinner at campsite at the edge of the pans outside Mosu village.

Monday: Transport back to Gaborone.

Sponsorship Fee/Registration Fee: P3,500.00. To be paid prior to the walk.

Meals: Breakfast, night lunch package and supper.
